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DIRECT ACCESS LAB

- No physician order required.
- Choose from a limited menu of tests.
- Affordable way to get lab results. No copays.

Direct Lab Access is a quick and inexpensive way for you to do lab tests without a healthcare provider's order. If you do not have health insurance or if you have high insurance deductibles and co-pays, you may find Direct Lab Access to be an affordable way to get the information you need.

SCMC Direct Access Lab is open to the general public Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. (no holidays.) There is no need to register, go directly to the front registration desk and pay for the lab you want and then proceed to Station 2. Your health insurance will not be billed. All tests must be paid for by cash before your specimen is obtained.

Tests will be completed the same day and sent to the address provided by you on the Direct Access Lab form. You may decide to wait for the results if the lab is able to run your specimen in a timely manner. In order to keep costs low, we will not send the results to your healthcare provider. The lab is unable to give anyone treatment advice, if you have a concern, please contact your healthcare provider. All test that require you to be fasting are noted on the lab test menu.

***Tests that require a fasting specimen means you must not have had anything to eat for at least 8 hours, to obtain the most accurate results you must fast for 12 hours. (You may take medicine with water and brush your teeth.

FAQs

Who can go?

It is available to anyone 18 years of age and older.

When is it open?

Direct Access Lab will be open Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. (no holidays.)

Where do I go?

There is no need to register. Go to the front registration desk and pay for your lab and then proceed to Station 2.

Does my doctor need to order these tests for me?

A physician's order is not required, however, we urge you to share the results with your regular healthcare provider.

Will a copy of the results be sent to my doctor?

To keep costs low, we will not send a copy to your provider. You will need to bring a copy of the lab results with you if you schedule an appointment with your healthcare provider.

What if I have questions about my lab results?

The Lab at SCMC is unable to give out any medical advice. If you have any questions, please contact your regular healthcare provider. LabTestsOnline.org is a public resource written by lab professionals. It was designed to help you better understand clinical laboratory test that are a part of routine care as well as diagnosis and treatment of a broad range of conditions and diseases.

Will you bill my insurance company?

Your insurance will not be billed, which also helps keep costs low. All test must be paid for by cash before the specimen is collected.

How long does it take?

It just takes a few minutes to fill out the form and collect the test samples. All tests are run on the same day and will be mailed to the address you provided on the form.
